Thankfully, the family (a mom and dad, a 15-year-old girl and a 14-year-old boy) was first transitioned into a homeless shelter, and more recently to an apartment that they can call home. The dad has a job opportunity as a mechanic lined up that begins right after the New Year, and the mom is enrolled in a job training program to expand her employment horizon.

While our Sunday School kids and their families alone were able to provide Christmas gifts to this needy family, we can all further support their efforts by extending their holiday blessings into the new year! In the midst of whatever griefs, or joys, or worries, or hopes we may be feeling, the baby Jesus comes. May we, through the help of the Holy Spirit (who sometimes works through a Christmas-themed movie) prepare him room. I'm ready to be ready. How about you?
