

### The State of OUR Union

*"The Lord is our Shepherd, we lack for nothing."* (Ps. 23:1) Those oh-so-familiar words from the 23rd Psalm (albeit from an unfamiliar translation) seem particularly pertinent for us as we begin this new year:

- Having felt the pain of the passings of Tom Gilbertson, Doloris Timmons and now Fred Schroeder in recent days, we may wonder if we still have what it takes to carry on in our work in this community ... but the Psalmist's words are a reassuring reminder that God is our shepherd, and that — because of God's abundant goodness — we lack for nothing that we need.
- Having recently witnessed a 'building up of the Body of Christ' in our midst through no particular efforts of our own (I'm seeing those new faces in worship among us and also the face of Vicar Meagan a gifted seminary intern that we didn't even make application for!) ... the Psalmist's words are an affirmation that God is the One who is watching out for both our present and our future as a community of believers!
- Having agonized over the ponderous construction project that we're engaged in, and knowing that patience is sometimes in short supply as we juggle the work of our congregation, our preschool program and our LARC program all at the same time ... the Psalmist's words are an invitation to 'take a deep breath' and remember that we truly do not lack for anything we need.

May we sense the Shepherd's presence in our own lives — and in our life together — as we walk boldly into the Year of our Lord 2025! May our anxieties be assuaged, may our hearts be joyfully surprised, and may we link arms with one another in trust and in community — in the awareness that, because the Lord IS our Shepherd, we truly do lack for nothing.

Sundays at 9:30 am — In-person worship with Holy Communion happens in our Sanctuary


Sundays at 9:30 am — Our inperson worship services are live on 'Facebook Live' @HSLCOrinda.
